



John Gomez Appointed to Granuflo Leadership Committee

San Diego, CA. - John Gomez, Lead Trial Attorney and Founder of Gomez Iagmin Trial Attorneys, has been appointed to leadership in the Granuflo litigation in California as a Plaintiff's Executive Committee member. Fellow executive committee members include attorneys Paul Sizemore, Paul Kiesel, and Tom Girardi. Mr. Gomez's appointment to the executive committee means Gomez Iagmin Trial Attorneys will take an active role in leading the litigation and trial strategy.

Due to the high volume of injured plaintiffs, which is thought to be in the thousands, these cases are being coordinated under one judge in Los Angeles Superior Court. Granuflo is a product produced by Fresenius, a large multi-billion dollar company which controls a large majority of the dialysis market.

Granuflo is a dialysate used during dialysis, a procedure to help patients with renal failure. However, Fresenius knowingly failed to warn the public and doctors about the amount of bicarbonate that entered the patient's bloodstream, causing metabolic alkalosis and sudden cardiac arrhythmia. Sudden cardiac arrhythmia is often fatal and dialysis patients or family members of dialysis patients may not even know the sudden cardiac arrhythmia was caused by Granuflo's increased bicarbonate levels.
